

SAN CANZIAN VILLAGE & HOTEL


In the heart of culinary Istria

DAY 3: Biking tour Parenzana with private guide

BIKE TOUR PARENZANA

With a mountain bike on the wine train route

At the beginning of the last century, the Parenzana was a ramshackle railway line connecting the Italian Trieste with Poreč in Istria for several dozen years. The 123-kilometer journey will take you past villages and towns and through beautiful dramatic landscapes. It was nicknamed the Wine Train, because of the countless vineyards along the route.

Trains have long since disappeared and the Parenzana has been converted into a highly regarded cycle route between Istria's northern hills. Today you will explore one of the most beautiful parts of this route. You will be picked up at the hotel and head your way to the village of Livade. From here you and your guide set off on a tough mountain bike. The ascent and descent rates are small - after all, the train had to be able to cope with them - so it is a comfortable ride through wonderfully untouched landscapes. After 27 kilometres you will arrive at Motovun, the end of the tour. From here you will return to San Canzian Hotel & Village



DAY 4 Truffle hunting with private guide

TRUFFLE HUNTING

The dogs love this exclusive treat

Istria is a culinary paradise and the truffle is the main gastronomic symbol of that fine cuisine. Grandpa Karlić started truffle hunting in Motovun forest in 1966. The very best truffles in all of Istria are found here. And now, for more than 50 years, the Karlić family is still searching for this refined delicacy with three generations and a pack of dogs.

After a short exposé on the history of the family, the first dishes are soon on the table: local cheese and ham, enriched with truffle and accompanied by a carafe of red and white wine, which comes from their own vineyard. Then mama Karlić prepares masterpiece of this luxurious ingredient: the truffle omelette. The eyes almost pop out when you see how generously the truffle is shaved into and over the omelette. Then it is time for a real truffle hunt. You set off to the forest where wildly enthusiastic dogs start their diligent research. It is also important that the guide keeps a close eye on them to prevent the truffles from being swallowed in one bite. The dogs are also very fond of this exclusive treat. After about 1.5 hours the "hunt" has come to an end and you continue your way, enriched with beautiful experience in nature



DAY 7 - 8 An overnight in a Luxury Suite in Fenomen Plitvice hotel, B&B service.

PLITVICE LAKES NATIONAL PARK

The Plitvice Lakes are magical nature reserve that has been under the UNESCO World Heritage List. It is a truly impressive and very busy area, where one scenery is even more beautiful than the next. It is a large park with a total of 16 lakes, divided into the 'upper lakes' and the 'lower lakes. The spectacular routes lead you along streams and waterfalls. Everywhere you look you will see the unbelievably blue and crystal-clear water.

If you are looking for peace and privacy, you arrived to the right place. Excellently equipped chalets in the middle of nature provide a very relaxed atmosphere.



The most beautiful (UNESCO) National park in Croatia

National park Plitvice are an extremely impressive park under the protection of the UNESCO World Heritage. It is one of the biggest tourist attractions in Croatia, therefore, it is very busy.

The area with a total of 16 lakes offers a huge range of hiking trails, each time with unique views. The different routes can be combined with boat connections. ZADAR

The 3000-year-old World Heritage town is beautifully situated in the Adriatic Sea with traces of the Greeks, Romans, Byzantines and Venetians who were all temporarily in charge during history. Historic old town of medieval churches, Roman ruins, cosmopolitan cafes and quality museums set on a small peninsula, Zadar is an intriguing city. It's not too crowded, it's not overrun with tourists, and its two unique attractions – the sound-and-light spectacle of the Sea Organ and the Sun Salutation – need to be seen and heard to be believed. The location is a great base for contemporary traveller. For example, you will find the islands of Ugljan and Dugi Otok, which are less crowded than the other more famous islands off the Croatian coast, just 30 minutes away. And while Ugljan is a beautiful island to explore by bicycle, Dugi Otok has beautiful villages and is one of the best places in Croatia for kayaking.

With a sailing boat or a private speedboat, you can visit the hundreds of islands of the Kornati national park. But there is also plenty to do on the mainland: The ancient royal city of Nin is less than 20 kilometers away and a bike ride over narrow gravel paths and along the coast is highly recommended. In short, Zadar has a lot to offer and will definitely be one of the highlights of any trip through Croatia.

BASTION HERITAGE HOTEL

Brilliant mix of Medieval beauty and top technology

In the ancient history, the Bastion Hotel was the stronghold from which Zadar was defended against unwanted invaders. Today Relais & Chateau Bastion hotel is in shiny condition. After the renovation in 2020 it regained the status of our favourite hotel in Zadar. The formerly somewhat old-fashioned hotel has been transformed into a technological 'state of the art' accommodation. You will stay in a real 'smart room', which is equipped with ultramodern features. What has remained the same is the perfect service level. You don't even have to leave the property for an excellent dinner: *Kaštel* is one of the best restaurants in all of Zadar and confirms the culinary reputation of the Relais & Chateau chain at a very high level.



The hotel has always been charming, and we liked to work with them because they always put extra effort to please our guests. After the recent renovation, it has resurrected as a phoenix. We recommend the Bastion Relais & Chateau again without any reserve.

DAY 9 - 11: Three days/ two nights sailing in the Zadar's archipelago on a sailing boat

SAILING THROUGH ZADAR'S ARCHIPELAGO

Sail in one of the most beautiful areas of the Adriatic

Today you will go out for three days / two nights tour on a sailing boat with your own captain. The Zadar's archipelago is the best starting point to explore the beautiful Croatian coast. In this exceptionally varied sailing area of over 400 km2 you will find hundreds of islands, of which only 20 are inhabited.

Everywhere you are surrounded by crystal clear water and every island is different: wherever you look you will see fascinating landscapes. There are two National parks in this area: Kornati Islands National Park and Telašćica National Park. Weather and wind determine where you are going and together with the captain you decide on the route. Swimming, snorkelling, a delicious lunch on board or an excellent dinner in one of the many restaurants. A few wonderful days on the sea are guaranteed!

DURATION: Three days/ two night

INCLUDED: Sailboat, skipper, fuel, insurance, snorkel gear

NOT INCLUDED: Meals, drinks, harbour fees, meals for the skipper (+/- 20euros per day)





DAY 11: After the sailing you will head off to Šibenik, a ride of approximately 1,5 hours.

ŠIBENIK

Where cities like Zadar and Dubrovnik attract a lot of visitors, Šibenik stays a bit behind for some incomprehensible reason. It is the underdog of the Adriatic coast even though it is the one of the very few cities to have two buildings under UNESCO protection: the famous St James Cathedral and St. Nicholas Fort. This city has much more to offer than medieval splendour. The surrounding nature is also magnificent: the beautiful Kornati islands National Park are easily accessible while the world-famous waterfalls of Krka are only a fifteen-minute drive away. The city also has a great culinary trump: restaurant Pelegrini is one of the best in all of Croatia and was awarded a Michelin star in March 2018. Add to that the very beautiful city centre and the excellent price/quality ratio and you will understand why we strongly recommend staying in Šibenik.



DAY 11 - 15: Four nights in two Superior Marina View rooms in D-Resort Šibenik, B&B service.

All in all, this is a great base to explore the still relatively undiscovered, but oh so beautiful Šibenik and its surroundings.

It took a while until we realized how special Šibenik really is. The first time I was there I got lost in the wrong part of the old town and the second time lunch ended in failure. With each next visit, I became more impressed by the charm of this undiscovered town

on the Dalmatian coast and the endless possibilities the area offered. We get nothing but positive feedback from our customers and over the years it has become our No. 1 hotel in Croatia.

DAY 13 Bike tour in Krka National Park with private guide

BIKING INTO THE UNDISCOVERED SIDE OF KRKA NATIONAL PARK

Adrenaline kick, waterfall swimming and a traditional lunch.

The tour starts with a real adrenaline rush, a spectacular zipline descent in three parts of 650 meters, 500 meters and 250 meters long, with a height difference of no less than 120 meter. You will enjoy the view over the impressive landscape like a bird. After this the cycling adventure begins. The first part leads to a beautiful view over the remains of the Kljucica fortress, situated high on a cliff. The canyon under it was one of the most important trade routes in the Middle Ages connecting the Ottoman Empire with Venice. The next stop offers a beautiful view over Lake Visovac with a 14th century Franciscan monastery in the middle, one of the photographic highlights of the national park. A beautiful descent to the Roški waterfalls follows. This is a green shaded oasis, a wonderful resting point on a hot summer day. Here you can take a walk along the series of waterfalls or enjoy the view from the Ozidjana cave. You can even take a boat trip to visit the Franciscan monastery that you previously admired from high up on the mountain. On a warm day it is also wonderful to take a refreshing dip in the Krka river. (of course, we provide towels).

After this we have a culinary surprise: a transfer to a private restaurant in an idyllic place and under a wonderfully cool canopy of trees. Here you enjoy a classic *peka*. This is the best-known Croatian rural dish; a large pan is filled with all kinds of goodies and is hermetically sealed on a hot layer of charcoal. After a few hours (don't worry, these are hours prior to your visit), it is ready, and you enjoy unbelievably tender and flavourful meat along with vegetables and potatoes. A delicious local wine accompanies this authentic culinary experience.



DAY 14 Quad bike tour in the hinterland of Split

QUAD BIKE TOUR IN THE HINTERLAND OF SPLIT

Get in touch with your wild side.

You will be picked up at 9 a.m. in the morning for a spectacular tour that will show you a completely different face of Croatia. It is amazing to arrive in a completely different world in less than an hour.

After the arrival in Sinj you start with a short instruction. This tour is very suitable for beginners because the quad bikes have an automatic gear and are in perfect condition. Your guide is a skilled professional and you determine the pace with him. In the unspoilt hinterland of Split, this private quad bike tour takes you through ever-changing landscapes. Uphill and downhill, through green meadows, along deserted villages and sweeping views everywhere. The roads are partly paved, partly gravel and occasionally you drive through the fields. The chance that you will encounter other tourists during this adventure is basically non-existent. Today you and your guide are alone in the world. The tour ends with a delicious lunch with local specialties in an idyllic spot in a farm. After lunch, you have a transfer back to your hotel.



DAY 15 Self - drive to Grand Park Hotel Rovinj. It will take approximately 4,5 hours, the longest ride on this trip.

DAY 15 - 19 Four nights in a Family Sea view room in Grand Park Rovinj Hotel, B&B service.
